**Working title:** open-source mHealth: Development and usage of open-source closed-loop systems for insulin delivery in Type 1 Diabetes self-care

**Abstract:**

The #WeAreNotWaiting movement is a global digital health phenomenon where people with type 1 diabetes all over the world engage in the development and usage of open-source closed-loop technologies to automate their insulin delivery. In her Ph.D. thesis, Bianca Jansky conducted an ethnographic study (from 2018-2019) on the lived experiences of people engaged in this movement within the German healthcare context, focusing on patient knowledge and activism.
