Information on the Seminar in Venice Venice International University, San Servolo

Program

Monday, November 16th, 9.20 a.m., to Wednesday, November 18th, 6.00 p.m. The full program is available on the website.

Accommodation

There are pre-reserved rooms, which participants may book. Most of these rooms are on the island San Servolo, a small amount of rooms is also available in the Istituto della Pieta on the main island of Venice. Of course, participants are absolutely free to stay anywhere else, too.

To book a room on San Servolo, the booking document ("Accomodation Rational Choice 2015.doc") must be filled out and sent to the reception on San Servolo by September 10th. By this date, a down payment of the rate for the first night and the tourist tax must be made.

If you would like to stay at the Istituto, get in touch with Patrick Riordan by August 1st, who organizes a group-booking. Here, too, the first night must be paid by credit card in advance.

Rates (in EUR per room and night, excluding tourist tax): San Servolo: Single 95,- to 120,- / double 135,- / triple 160,-Istituto: Single 55,- to 80,- / double 100,- / triple 125,- / quadruple 150,- / five person room 175,- / six person room 200,-

Bills must be covered during the stay by each participant individually. The pre-booked rooms are allocated on a "first come, first serve"-basis.

Conference Fee

The rent for the conference room and facilities is kindly covered by the Institute for Sociology at LMU. There is no conference fee.

Presentations: Talks

Talks should be no longer than 20 minutes to leave ca. 10 minutes for questions and discussion. The conference language is German. However, we ask all presenters to prepare English slides and the talks on Wednesday will mostly be delivered in English. We also welcome English talks on the other days. A windows-computer with MS PowerPoint and a

PDF-reader and a projector are available. Mac users, who want to use their own computer, require a VGA-adapter.

Presentations: Posters

Maximum size: DIN A0 portrait format or DIN A1 landscape format. Poster panels are provided by VIU. Right before the poster session, poster presenters may give a short introduction – max. 2 minutes – of their work to the audience.

Internet on San Servolo

To access the wifi in the conference room or the PC room, please use the login and password provided by e-mail before the seminar. Participants staying on San Servolo have free access to the wifi from their rooms.

Facilities on San Servolo

The reception is open 24 hours. There is a refectory, where breakfast, lunch, and dinner are served. The set meals for lunch and dinner are usually around EUR 11,- and breakfast is EUR 7,-. The refectory is cash only! Please bear in mind that there is no ATM on San Servolo. There is also a bar, which provides drinks, coffee, and small snacks between 8 a.m. and 7 p.m.

Directions
